Beautify Tallassee NOW Weekend

The Greater Tallassee Area Chamber of Commerce will be sponsoring various events to beautify Tallassee, May 8 – 9, 2009. On Friday May 8 from 5 – 9 pm bring your lawnmowers and service supplies to the Tallassee High School Ag Center. Here you will get free expert help to change oil, sharpen blades, and tune the engines. Don't forget to bring your parts and/or supplies. On May 9 the city lot will be open from 9 am to 2 pm for citizens to bring their yard clippings, yard and woody waste (limbs are to be cut into 6 foot sections) old furniture, old metal, appliances, etc. Refrigeration units must be free of coolant and oil. Paint can be taken if it has been dried out...remove lid and place oil dry or kitty litter in it and let dry until hardened. The lot will be manned by city employees and we will have containers onsite for materials. Parker Tire will be open Saturday morning and will take used motor oil at no charge.
